### **Church Services**

We are very happy to be welcoming you to worship in church this Sunday. Please arrive in plenty of time as there are procedures required that will slow entry down. We will be guiding you to your seats to maintain 2m distancing. Three empty seats between family groups will provide this. There will be a one-way system, entering church through the main door and leaving via the tower doors. We will have hand sanitisers at entry and exit. We are allowed music but not singing. There will be no refreshments at the end of the service,

but we will still have a Zoom coffee time when you get home. The centre is now open, so the toilets are available.

Face coverings are mandatory in places of worship. Please could you bring your own mask. This is not a replacement for safe distancing which should still be maintained. Gloves are optional. The welcomers etc will be wearing masks and gloves as they might come within the 2m zone. You may wish to bring your own water bottle too.

At the end of the service, we will exit one row at a time. Please cooperate with the welcomers who will let you know when it is safe for your row to leave. Please do not meet up with others in the church, but wait until you are outside, where maximum of 6 people are permitted to meet by government guidelines.

We are continuing to live stream services. Please make it known to the welcomer showing you to your seat if you do not want to be filmed and they will find you an appropriate place to sit.

## **Children**

Although we are not allowed to have a creche or children's activity table in church yet, children are very welcome to come to church and sit with their family. They can bring an activity or two with them (nothing too noisy please). Children under the age of 11 are exempt from wearing a face covering. Of course, they can if they want to.

After our Harvest Festival on October 11th, we will be distributing gifts to the elderly and frail in our village, and also to the food bank and homeless in the wider local area co-ordinated by the Renewed Hope Trust. So if you wish to donate harvest gifts please give things that are suitable either for our elderly and frail villagers or items on the list below for Renewed Hope Trust. It would also help enormously if we make sure anything we give has a long "use-by" date. N.B. If you know someone who would appreciate some harvest gifts locally, please get in touch with the parish office. We will need a squad of volunteers to

help sort the harvest gifts and make up the local parcels after the service on October 11th. Please let Jackie know if you can help with this – we will, of course, maintain appropriate social distance and wear gloves. The more help we get the better it is for all of us!


